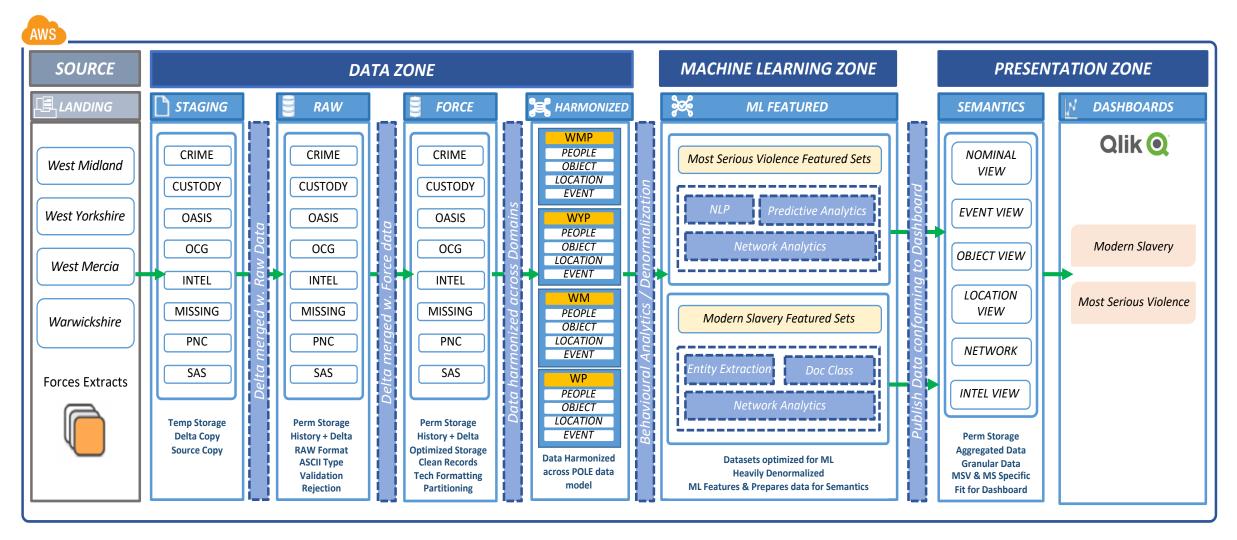

- To utilise this Network information as a foundation to discover previously unidentifiable MS patterns and trends

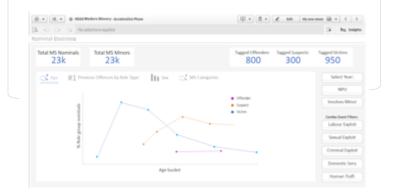

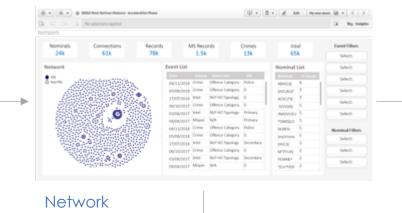

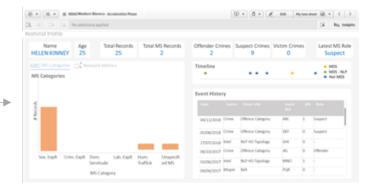


### Overview Trends: Events
