ACC Hawkins	OPEN	30.09.20	21.09.20: On 26 th August 2020 the pathway from Police Scotland into NHS 24 Mental Health Hub launched. Since this date over 140 calls have been assessed as suitable and the callers have been referred to the hub to enable those individuals to receive the right care at the right time. To date callers referred to the NHS 24 Hub have included individuals who had previously contacted Police Scotland several times for help in the absence of other services. Critically the majority of these callers have received compassionate care and support from the practitioners within the Hub and have not required further follow on care. Progress will be closely monitored via the Mental Health Strategic Steering Group and reporting to the SPA CAM Oversight Group.
