Direct measures seek to have a positive impact on individuals by not criminalising them unnecessarily, maximising efficiencies and use of officer time.  This work is being pursued by the Criminal Justice Improvement Group and in addition to national discussions about the criteria for issue, the group has enhanced communications / briefings for officers to highlight how direct measures can be built into appropriate decision making when considering how to proceed. This is something the force will continue to monitor going forward.  12/09/23 – Police Scotland have 4 recommendations as part of the HMICS Diversion from Prosecution joint inspection. Members have requested that Police Scotland will present their improvement plan and progress report on these recommendations.
